Camp Site Office

The **BunkFest** Camp Site Office will be open

Thursday 1st	1800 – 2100
Friday 2nd	1100 – 2100
Saturday 3rd	0800 – 2100
Sunday 4th	0800 – 1200

The Campsite Office will issue all camping bookings reserved in advance, whether pre-paid or otherwise. It will also sell Camping Passes, Season Tickets and Programmes.

If no **BunkFest** Stewards are available when you arrive, please go straight on to campsite and set up within the marked out spaces. Collect your passes later! A **BunkFest** Steward will check for passes and will chase you for fees if you are not already displaying your permit (s)!

The campsite may be used by caravans, camper vans, motor homes etc. You may leave cars near your tents at all times. But please observe safety guidance.

Please camp tidily, following the markers.

We must ensure emergency access to all areas of the campsite - please do not obstruct access ways.

Information for Campers

The **map** overleaf shows the site and its facilities.

Please park in the designated areas without blocking **emergency access** routes. Reserved **disabled spaces** are clearly marked. You may leave cars near your tent at all times. Caravans, camper vans and motor homes should be located in designated areas. Camping **passes** must be displayed on the outside of your tent or vehicle at all times. Passes are for individuals not pitches.

The area close to the Pavilion may be slightly noisier due to late night club events. So if you want **peace and quiet**, try parking at far end of site.

We regret we cannot allow **dogs** on site, except Assistance Dogs.

Please be aware of the **Brook** on the south of the campsite, especially at night after sampling our real ale!

No open **fires** or barbeques are allowed.

Fire buckets are for emergency use, not for water fights! Please do not remove from the allocated positions unless in the case of an emergency.

Please dispose of **all rubbish** in the Grundon bin by the campsite entrance.

The permanent toilet and washing facilities are provided and used by the Sports Park members. Please have respect and leave them in a clean and tidy condition. Additional temporary toilets are provided on the field. A chemical toilet disposal point will be available near the Sports Park Toilets - please ask in the Pavilion for access during opening hours (check with John).

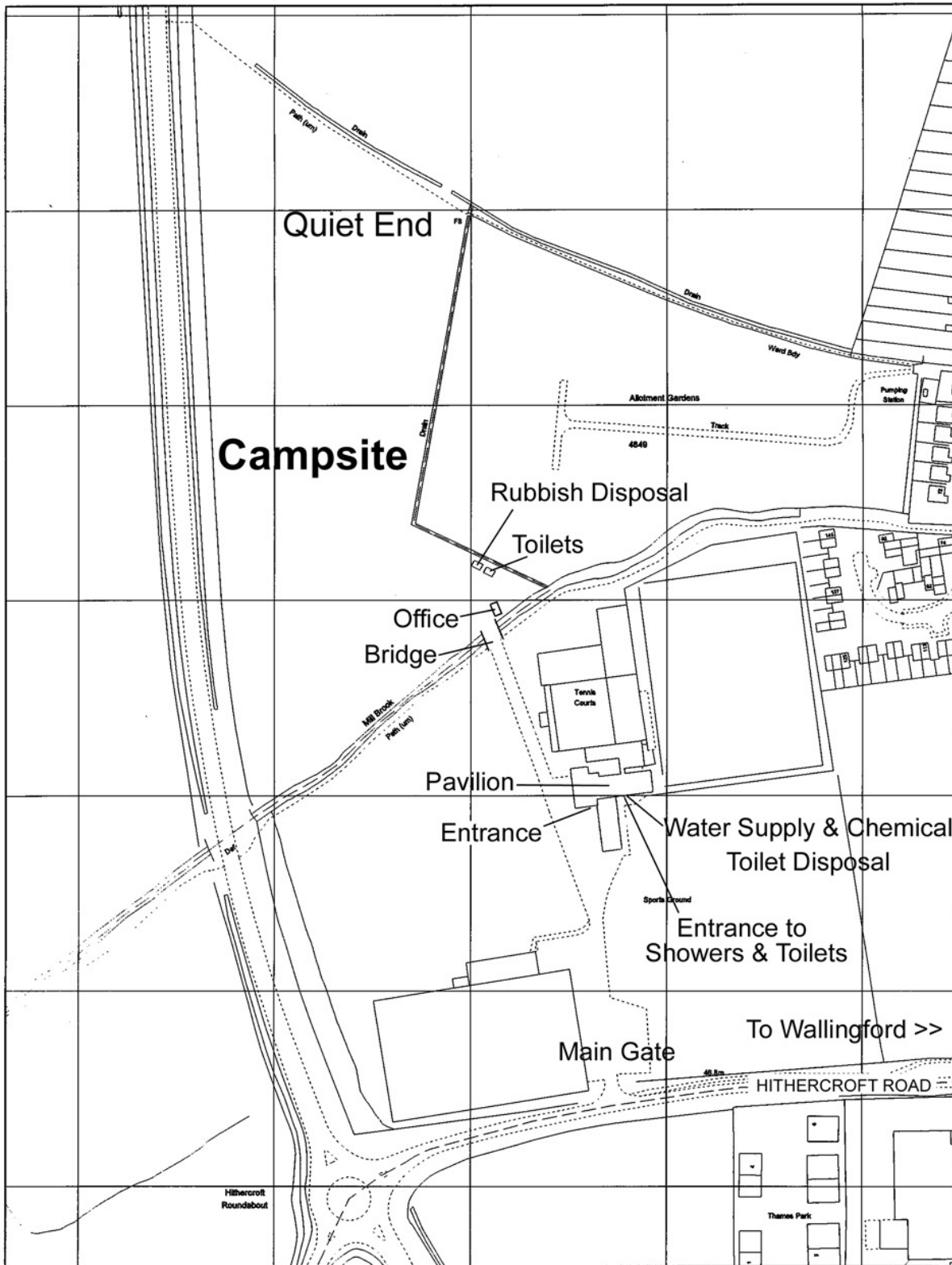
Drinking water can be obtained from the water point shown on the map.
