Community Street Fair – Saturday 2nd September 2006

Now in its fifth year, Wallingford BunkFest has grown to be one of the most lively and popular festivals in the calendar. BunkFest 2006 promises to be even bigger, with concerts, dance displays, ceilidhs, a beer festival, special events for young people, a huge craft fair, workshops, a storytelling fringe and much more. This year's BunkFest is entitled "Community and Culture Edition" with special emphasis on the town's many community groups and projects. Part of this, new for 2006, is a Community Street Fair on Saturday 2nd September in the Town Centre. With over 15,000 visitors expected, some roads will be closed to traffic 1000 to 1600 on Saturday 2 September so that everyone can enjoy the event safely. We have a lot of support for this approach. St Martin's Street will be blocked at the Lamb crossroads and at the Methodist Church. Market Place will be closed. St Leonard's Square will remain open.

A variety of street entertainers, dancers and stalls from local community groups will plying their trade. In response to local requests, this will NOT include any Fairground rides! We hope you will all want to be involved. Stalls will be sited in Feathers Yard, St Mary's pedestrian area, Market Place, pavements in St Martin's Street and Southern area of St Mary's Street. Dancing will take place in Market Place, Dolphin and in the closed streets.

Stalls may be set up from 0800 and taken down after 1600, but vehicular access will not be allowed in the area from 1000-1600. I hope you can schedule your collections/deliveries accordingly.

The BunkFest Park and Ride bus service will be operating from two free temporary parking areas at Hithercroft Road Industrial Estate and the South Oxfordshire District Council offices car park in Crowmarsh. So people can plan their travel arrangements well in advance, Thames Travel bus diversions for Saturday 2 September are detailed below. Full details on all bus diversions and taxi pick up locations will be available at the Town Information Office (open until 1600) and on the BunkFest website. www.bunkfest.co.uk. Thames Travel and BunkFest apologise to all bus passengers for any inconvenience these diversions may cause.

Bus services departing Wallingford BEFORE 1000 and AFTER 1600 will depart from the normal stops in the Market Place. Whilst the Market Place is closed from 1000-1600, buses will depart from the following points in the HIGH STREET:

Whilst the Market Place is closed **SERVICE 130** will not be able to serve Blackstone Road on journeys from Wallingford to Didcot and will operate via St. Georges Road to Wilding Road. **SERVICE 135** from CHOLSEY will operate into Wallingford via Crowmarsh setting down at Wallingford House, High Street.
